Colour Correction

For this project, you will be completing 3 videos and submitting them all.

These will be submitted as one movie with 4 sections!

- **1.** I would like you to shoot a scene with the camera's white balance set to Auto.
- **2.** I would like you to shoot the same scene using custom white balance. Follow <u>these</u> instructions on how to set correct white balance in your Canon DSLR camera.
- If you will be panning or moving from one light source to another while shooting this scene, you may end up with poor results, as the colour temperature will change during shooting. Consider not having multiple locations (ie. not moving the camera outside during a shot)
- **3.** I would like you to re-film the first scene (same location, dialogue, etc.) but this 3rd video clip must be shot with the color balance of your camera set to the wrong setting (ie. shade.) There are good instructions here on how to change your white balance.
- * You must incorporate a shot of a grey or white card during the initial few seconds of your scene!
- **4.** Upload your clips to the correct location and create a Premier Pro project in the same location. You will now be creating a project with 4 sections. Please label each section according to what the white balance was set to:
- a.) The first section will be the "Auto" White Balance scene. There is no need to edit this clip.
- b.) The second section will be Custom white balance. Again, no need to edit this scene.
- c.) The third scene will be a split screen clip where you will use the fast colour corrector in Premier Pro to show that you can use a Grey Card to balance footage shot with the incorrect white balance. This video explains how.
- d.) The fourth scene will be either the first or second clip intentionally altered using the fast colour corrector. This <u>video</u> explains how.

Please incorporate titles into your.
You will be handing in a 4 segment film.
This will be titled "Your Name colour.mov"
Cell phone video is acceptable, or point and shoot footage.
