Final Film Project 2015 (FF2015)

This project will be a culmination of all the techniques you have learned over the year. It may be in any genre you wish.

1. As with previous projects, you'll be following a logical progression that will be starting with a synopsis. The difference with this project is that you need to "pitch it" to me, and get my approval, in order to go ahead.

Essentially, I will be your producer, that is, the one who would be funding this project if you were in Hollywood. Your "pitch" must involve each one of your team presenting to me the plot overview and characters.

You must list in this synopsis, who will be in charge of:

Audio capture

Title sequence

Editing

- **2.** I expect that you will also be presenting a screenplay. I will review this screenplay and go over it with the writer, or whoever's name is attached to it.
- **3.** Next you will be creating a storyboard. This must incorporate any special shots or angles that are used. Please be aware that shots and angles will be marked quite heavily for this piece.
- **4.** Shotlist. 'nuff said, I expect this to be bullet proof.
- **5.** Timelapse. This must be incorporated into your production in a cohesive manner. The duration must be *at least* 5 seconds, or 50 frames.
- **6.** Audio. You must incorporate audio that is captured separately from the video, using (a) microphone(s) and/ or an audio capture device.
- **7.** Title sequence. This should have a downloaded and appropriate font, as well as be creative and appropriate for the film. You might find some inspiration <u>here.</u>
