## Music Video Project

For this project you will be creating a video to highlight a song of your choice.

Classical, western, heavy metal...no problem, take your pick.

You may choose any song (keep it PG, please).

You may choose to do a narrative (storytelling) piece (could be based on the songs

lyrics), or simply create imagery to accompany a piece.

You will be working in a group with no more than 4 members.

Criteria is as follows:

- **1.** You will be expected to use a wide array of <u>shots</u> and <u>angles</u> based on learning from previous assignments.
- 2. The progression of your images must be thoughtful
- 3. You will be submitting a synopsis for this project
- 4. You must incorporate an "L" and a "J" cut into your project
- **5.** You will incorporate an animation sequence where you will become familiar with the concept of keyframes. (Follow along with <u>this</u> tutorial)
- **6.** You have the choice of submitting a screenplay, or, if you are doing more of a visual piece, a storyboard and a <u>shotlist</u> (follow this link and select "shotlist.docx" for a template)
