TimeLapse

TimeLapse is the technique of portraying a rapid succession of time, in a short amount of time, by prolonging the duration between shots, while still maintaining some semblance of a motion picture...whew! That was long winded!

What you are going to do, is go to page 155 of this instruction manual for the Nikon D7000 SLR, (which happens to have an interval meter on it so you can do this without much fancy equipment.)

Follow the instructions to the letter, and make sure that your battery is fully charged (you should charge the battery in the charger in the cabinet outside my office door during the school day.) The charger must remain at the school.

You'd probably do well to research this topic and find some inspiration by viewing some pieces online.

Once you have your images, follow along with this tutorial and then import the .mov into the editing bay of your choice.

You must have a title and a music score!

Your project must be handed in as a .mov

You may choose any genre you like!
