

Photo installation

For my project, I would like to look at the concept of closed spaces. Not in relation to living spaces, but to actually being cramped in tight quarters. I conceived this concept after having dreams of being caught in a cave when I worked at Horne Lake Caves on Vancouver Island. I will be taking photos of a person cramped inside a box, shot from the side. This will have the approximate dimensions of the 8" x 10" cube box that I am making to house the photo. It will be viewed through a peephole similar to those found on apartment doors. I will have a light inside the box that will be actuated by the viewer of the piece. I am thinking of mounting this on a steel support rod and affixing the other end in Concrete in a bucket. The box will be made of 5/8th inch plywood, with a finish attached to it.

- 4- 8"x10" pieces of plywood
- 2- 10"x10" pieces of plywood
- brad nails
- glue
- drill bit (9/16th) for peephole, 1/4" for switch
- Pipe fittings
- Pipe,
- Bucket
- Concrete
- Lightbulb
- Switch
- Wire
- Plug
- Socket
- Peephole
